EWU does not allow any political activities within its campus

Recently a discussion has started on allowing student political activities in private universities. It is undeniable that in Bangladesh, student politics has a remarkable history, and its contribution to the liberation movement is indelible. East West University also acknowledges this contribution of the students. Our university has a distinct vision and goal which promotes tolerance, respect, openness, and inclusivity through its extracurricular and co-curricular activities.

However, fact remains that East West University is a non-political and not-for-profit academic institution that aspires to be an institution of international level with its excellent teaching and learning and research, and does not allow any political activity within its campus. It is thus expected that all concerned will devote themselves to developing EWU as a center of Excellence in Education and will use its campus and resources solely for the purpose of education and research and relevant co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Members of the EWU community, however, are free to express their political views outside the campus. The university cannot, under any circumstances, be labeled or established as a venue for student politics.

It is forbidden to use the EWU name and logos for political purposes, nor the university's buildings, premises nearby streets, or other properties for the same.
