Teach For Bangladesh: An Overview

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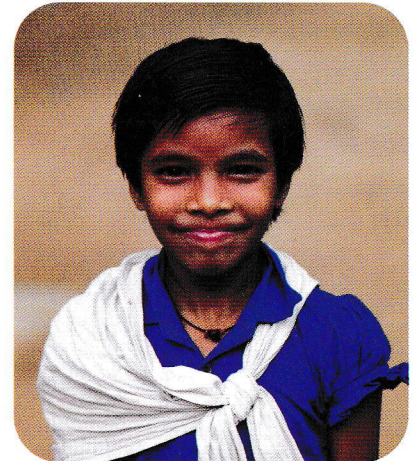
Teach For Bangladesh (TFB) is a non-profit organization that is working to address systemic disparity in education and to ensure that all children in Bangladesh are able to live up to their full potential.

Ours is a collective movement of youth leaders, students, schools, and community members working to build a more just and inclusive Bangladesh. Our flagship program, the TFB Fellowship enlists high-potential leaders to serve as full-time teachers in under-resourced

schools for two years, and work long-term to solve some of the most enduring challenges in education.

OUR VISION

We envision a society in which all children receive an excellent education that empowers them to realize their full potential and shape their own future through talent and hard work.



THE CHALLENGE

Despite increases in school enrollment over the past decades, Bangladesh has struggled to translate access to schooling into meaningful learning for the vast majority of students. According to World Bank, 75% of Grade 5 students in Bangladesh do not demonstrate minimum proficiency in mathematics and 43% of Grade 3 students were unable to answer a single question on a test of Bangla literacy. The challenges at the primary school level carry all the way through secondary and tertiary education, with one-third of the graduates unable to find employment in 2019.

Millions of children in Bangladesh are denied high-quality education as a result of an inequitable system. Their agency and opportunity to succeed personally, academically, and professionally are limited by the socio-economic condition of their families.

These inequities have been further exacerbated by the Covid-19 pandemic, during which children were out of school for 18 consecutive months. The digital divide meant that the most vulnerable students were disproportionately affected, resulting

not only in learning loss, but also psychosocial distress, increased dropout, etc.

OUR APPROACH

The Teach For Bangladesh Fellowship is building a pipeline of leaders to work collectively to reshape education in Bangladesh in the form of teacher-leaders known as Fellows and their students.

Each year thousands of graduates and young professionals apply to our competitive Fellowship program. Participants are selected for their values and demonstrated leadership potential, and deployed to our partner schools to work as teachers for the next two years.

- During this time, TFB Fellows work with students, parents, teachers, and the community to drive student growth.
- In the process, they transform their own vision, values, and leadership capacity.
- As Alumni of the program, they continue to drive innovation and change inside and outside the education sector, drawing inspiration and insight from their experience as classroom teachers.

OUR IMPACT

Teach For Bangladesh has expanded its operation in Dhaka and Chattagram and is now poised to scale the program to additional regions while deepening the impact on existing ones.
